Urban Discovery Academy Schools

UDA/id8High provides students with a high-quality, personalized education which inspires student inquiry and creativity. We utilize an interdisciplinary approach, design-thinking, and project-based learning methodologies to ensure students are engaged, and classroom learning is meaningful and applied. We work closely with our partners to extend learning beyond the classroom walls and allow students to solve real-world problems.

What is a charter school?

Charter schools are public schools authorized by local school districts as schools of choice. Charter schools are tuition-free. Charter schools are financially autonomous, have local-decision making capability which enables flexibility, and budget independence. As a result, charter schools typically create a mission-driven educational program which flexibly serves the needs of their students.

How does a charter school differ from a traditional public school?

Many charter schools have an independent governance structure. Like public schools, charter schools receive funding from state and local agencies, primarily relating to attendance of its students; however, charter schools receive less money than public schools, approximately 72¢ on the dollar.

What makes UDA/id8High special?

- UDA/id8High creates a vibrant and caring community with smaller class sizes; feels like family
- Parents love the progressive and high-quality teachers and staff
- UDA spends \$300,000 on unique, interdisciplinary enrichment programs, including performing arts, fine arts, STEAM, physical education, after school athletics, and Spanish
- UDA spends over \$30,000 on classroom project supplies each year
- UDA spends over \$50,000 each year on field trips, where students learn from first-hand experiences
- By the time UDA/id8High students graduate, they will have completed an internship and met the requirements for admission to the University of California system

What is Project Based Learning?

Project Based Learning is a teaching method in which students gain knowledge and skills by working for an extended period of time to investigate, collaborate and respond to an authentic, engaging, and complex question, problem, or challenge.

Why, does UDA/id8High need additional funding?

- Funding inequity between charter schools and traditional school districts (72¢ on the dollar), a difference of nearly \$300,000
- Charter schools are on their own to finance facilities out of general operating funds, pay district oversight fees, and provide back-office business support
